In the Disney movie, "The Prince of Egypt" there was a scene where Moses is invited to dinner with his father in law, Jethro. Jethro starts to help Moses, who is going through his "on the back side of the mountain experience" to understand that we can't always look at life as we see it on the earth. He begins to sing to him a song. I felt compelled to list the lyrics so that all who read this article can get the effect of what Jethro was saying even if you haven't seen the meaning. The lyrics are as follows: *"A single thread in a tapestry, Though its color brightly shines, Can never see its purpose, In the pattern of the grand design. And the stone that sits on the very top Of the mountain mighty face, Does it think it's more important, Than the stones that form the base? So how can you see what your life is worth, Or where your value lies? You can never see through the eyes of man, You must look at your life through heaven's eyes. A lake of gold in the desert sand Is less than a cool fresh spring And to one lost sheep, a shepherd boy Is greater than the richest king. If a man lose everything he owns Has he truly lost his worth? Or is it the beginning Of a new and brighter birth? So how can you measure the worth of a man In wealth or strength or size? In how much he gained or how much he gave? The answer will come to him who tries, To look at his life from heaven's eyes. No life can escape being blown about, By the winds of change and chance, And though you never know all the steps, You must learn to join the dance! So how do you judge what a man is worth*

By what he builds or buys? You can never see with your eyes on earth, Look at your life through heaven's eyes!" We tend to view our life from one perspective only. Our own. It is the oldest trick in the book. The enemy used it way back in the garden. It is the trap to view things only from your own self-centered, introspective eyes. Our souls enemy, Satan, got Adam and Eve, who were made in the image and likeness of God, to believe that God hadn't given his best, or told them the best plan for their lives, and that He was holding back on their abilities, by not allowing them to have the knowledge of good and evil. We must come out of our shells, and understand that our lives are not our own, and they are not about what we desire, and how we want each day to look, but our lives are about the divine design. God is processing us to make us into what he has already planned before you were formed in your mother's womb. It's exciting to know that everyday has been recorded or written in his book.
