Pastors Perspective: Get up and Plow! By Apostle Moore

Who are You Listening To? Part I Minister Willie Edwards

There are many voices we here everyday and every week. Most times its people's personal opinions about what we should do and why they would or wouldn't do or how they would handle a certain situation. We understand that being in a ministry that the man or woman God has placed in our lives is the mouth piece of God used to speak into our lives. In every decision we make and in every situation we are faced with there will always be five different voices speaking to us.

1. The voice of God
2. The voice of your conscience
3. The voice of your reasoning
4. The voice of your flesh, and
5. The voice of the devil

This is a guarantee; in most cases each voice will lead you in the opposite direction of the voice of God. I have seven brothers and sister and plenty other relatives in my family, as well as some of you do. There are certain ones that if they call me I can detect their voice immediately. Each one has a distinctive sound or pitch. In the spirit, the five voices are the same way! They each have a distinctive sound pitch. The way we get to know their sound pitch is through the word of God.

Since the word tells "the last shall be first and the first shall be last" we will start with **The Voice of the Devil – (Psalm 55:1-3)**. This how the voice of the devil sounds. When he speaks, his voice comes to:

- Deceive you, (Revelation 20:7-8)
- Cause you to doubt God's word, (Hebrews 3:12)
- Cause division in your family, church, business, (Mark 3:25)
- Discourage you, (Numbers 32:6-10)
- Cause you to disobey the word of God, (Joshua 5:6)
- Blind your mind, (II Corinthians 4:4)
- Bring you fear, (Mark 4:40)
- Stir up unforgiveness, (Matthew 6:15)
- Cause you not to hear God's voice, (John 10:5)

So, if you hear confusion, fear, doubt, etc. you're listening to the voice of the devil.

The Voice of Your Flesh - (Galatians 5:16-21)

Your flesh speaks to you in a commanding and authoritative sound pitch. It speaks to you on a daily basis. Anytime we follow the flesh, the net result will always turn out negative. When you listen to the voice of the flesh you engage in:

- Adultery – unlawful sexual relations between a man and a woman
 - Fornication – pornography, harlotry
 - Uncleaness – homosexuality, lesbianism, pedophile
 - Revellings – clubs, house parties,
 - Heresies – causing discord,
 - Variance – to quarrel with words, stir up strife and incite debates
 - Strife – getting back for wrong, angry contentions
 - Hatred – hold grudges and malice and be angry at someone
 - Seditions – stirring up strife in the church, home, government, etc
